## REPORT

[To accompany H. Res. 337]

The Committee on Rules, having had under consideration House Resolution 337, by a nonrecord vote, report the same to the House with the recommendation that the resolution be adopted.

### SUMMARY OF PROVISIONS OF RESOLUTION

The resolution waives all points of order against the conference report to accompany H.R. 2466, the Department of the Interior and Related Agencies Appropriations Act, 2000, and against its consideration. The rule further provides that the conference report shall be considered as read.

The waiver of all points of order includes a waiver of clause 8 of rule XXII (requiring a three-day layover of a conference report) because the conference report was not made available until Wednesday, October 20, and it may be considered as early as Thursday, October 21. Also, the waiver of all points of order includes a waiver of clause 9 of rule XXII (prohibiting matters not specifically committed to the conference from being included in the conference report).
